The Program operates Monday through Thursday from 4:10 PM to 5:10 PM and Friday morning. **All programs are in the afternoon unless stated otherwise.** Morning programs are 8:00 AM to 8:50 AM. Afternoon programs are 4:10PM-5:10PM. We are limited to the number of students we service and only the **first 200 students** to return this form will be enrolled.

The Program will not be held on the days that school is not in session or on professional development days (PDD). Your son/daughter will be given a schedule in time for you to make arrangements for pick up at 5:10 PM sharp, in front of the school in the west parking lot. There is no charge for this program; however, your child must be picked up by 5:10 PM.

Course Descriptions

A.M. Early Bird Study Hall - This course is designed to allow students the opportunity to be on campus early, in a supervised environment, to work on homework or class work. The course is held in the Cafeteria. Breakfast is also available starting at 8:30AM.

A.M. Morning Media Lab – This course is designed to allow students to use the computers before classes. Room 1-135

AM and PM Project Read ESOL – This course is designed to provide extra help in reading for those students who are enrolled in the English Speakers of Other Languages/LEP program. The course is held in room 3-206. Students will also use computers.

Basketball PM – This course is designed to allow students to engage in free play sports activities. The course is held on the outside basket courts and gymnasium.

Homework Assistance Math.– This course is designed to allow students to receive tutoring in Math, extra help with classwork/homework. The course is held in room 3-201.

Homework Assistance Language Arts – This course is designed to allow students to receive tutoring in English Language Arts, extra help with classwork/homework. The course is held in room 1-203.

TV Production – This activity is designed for students who are interested in learning about TV Production. The class will meet in the Media Center TV Studio.
